History 5049-01 Course Syllabus Readings in the Modern Middle East Spring 2011 Professor George L. Simpson, Jr.

The focus of this graduate seminar will be on the history of Israel. Each week all the students will read journal articles, documents, or book chapters or combinations of these as preparation for class. Students will read a single book and write a three- to five-page (750-1,250 word) review of that work. At the conclusion of the course, all students will write a ten- to twelve-page (2,500 to 3,000) review of the literature. You will receive a handout explaining how to write book reviews as well as the review of the literature.

Classes will consist of student presentations and class discussions of each week's readings. Students are expected to offer constructive criticism of each other's work and ideas. I will grade students based on both their written presentations and classroom participation with the reviews counting sixty percent of the final grade, classroom discussion counting twenty percent, and the review of the literature worth twenty percent. Grading is on a ten-point scale.

The goal of the course is to give students a firm knowledge base in the subject matter of the course as well as about various historical interpretations of this general topic. Students who complete this class should be prepared to take the Modern Middle East writing seminar if they so choose.
